The Board of Directors of Historic Centennial Neighborhood Association has voted to support a grant proposal to fund the design of the Brown Street bicycle and pedestrian bridge. We understand the bridge design and its implementation would be sensitive to the two historic buildings at 500 N. 3rd Street: the brick office building and the lumber shed/storage building.
